Maj Gen TM Pattnaik SM, GOC 14 Inf Div and Patron APS Birpur graced the event as the Chief Guest. 9 APSs grouped in cluster 2, participated with full zeal and enthusiasm. The event commenced with a welcome note by the Vice Head Girl and Vice Head Boy. Amidst chanting of mantras the auspicious lamp was lit by the dignitaries.

The debaters exhibited excellent rhetorical skills and thoughtful arguments on the topic, 'The entry of foreign universities as proposed under NEP 2020 will help higher education in India.' The speakers were allowed 4 minutes each to deliver their arguments in either favour or against the motion. The interjectors of opponent teams too put up intelligent questions to the speakers. The sequence of speakers and their interjecting team was decided by a draw of lot.
