SCHOOL ACTIVITIES HELD FROM 17 JUL TO 31 JUL 2024

6TH JUNIOR GIRLS AND BOYS STATE BOXING TOURNAMENT

The 6th Junior Girls and Boys State Boxing Tournament was held at Sports Stadium Parade Ground from 14-16 Jul 2024. A total of six students from APS Birpur participated in this tournament. Out of these, two students won Silver Medals (Simran from cl X and Ayushi from cl XI), and two students won Bronze Medals (Riya from cl X and Pranjal from cl XI).





MUKHYAMANTRI UDIYAMAAN KHILADI UNNAYAN YOJNA

Under the Mukhyamantri Udiyamaan Khiladi Unnayan Yojna, students from APS Birpur (Primary Wing) participated in a series of races. Eight students were selected at the Nyay Panchayat level (7-8 July 2024), with seven advancing to the block level (12-13 July 2024) and district level (18-20 July 2024). Six of these students have been awarded a scholarship of Rs 1500 per month for a year. The students were coached by Ms. Sushila Rana, P.E.T (Primary Wing). INTER ARMY SCHOOL QUIZ COMPETITION, GORAKHPUR

Army Public School Birpur participated in Central Command Cluster 1 Quiz Competition held on 20 Jul 2024 at APS Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh. Total eight teams from different school participated in the competition. Three students Ayushi Chaudhary (cl XII), Aditya Gobari (cl X), Tejas (cl X) participated in the competition and secured Fifth position.





SAFAL (STRUCTURED ASSESSMENT FOR ANALYSING LEARNING) EXAMINATION 2024

APS Birpur conducted the SAFAL online examination from 22 Jul 2024 to 13 Aug 2024 for students in cl V & VIII focusing on English Language, Science/EVS, and Mathematics. A total of 120 students from cl V & VIII were randomly selected by CBSE. The exam was conducted in three batches daily, with each batch consisting of 20 students.





AWAKENED CITIZEN PROGRAMME SURVEY REPORT

An online survey was conducted for the students of cl VII on 24 Jul 2024 as a part of the ACP (Awakened Citizens Programme). Resource person, Mr. Arnab Ghosh from

Ramakrishna Mission facilitated the session. He provided detailed instructions for conducting the survey and also ensured that the students understand the process thoroughly. The students were engaged and actively participated in the survey. The event was successful in its objective of collecting valuable feedback from the students.





VISIT TO RIMC

On 25th July 2024, in commemoration of Kargil Vijay Diwas, 44 students from classes IX and XI of APS Birpur visited the Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC). The group included 23 students from class IX and 21 students from class XI. The visit was both memorable and educational, offering students a unique opportunity to learn about military history and values. A live concert by the Army band was the highlight of the visit, leaving a lasting impression on the students.

On 25 Jul 2024, APS Birpur organized a Class Decoration Competition for the cl VI - XII. Students showcased their creativity and teamwork by decorating their respective classrooms. PSYCHOLOGY WEEK

The psychology students of Cl XI & XII at APS Birpur conducted "Psychology Week" from 25 - 31 Jul 2024, themed "Abraham Maslow -A Journey of Self-Actualization."

STUDENT COUNCIL ELECTION

On 2 Aug 2024, APS Birpur held its annual student council election, fostering leadership and democratic values within the school community. The event began with the announcement of nominated candidates, each committed to representing their peers. The candidates then introduced themselves in brief speeches, outlining their goals and visions.
