Upon arrival, the students were greeted by research scholars of the institute who then briefed them about the functioning and importance of the museum as well as the institute. Students also observed real time seismic data at the institute. The institute also has a Multi-Parametric Geophysical Observatory in Tehri, which further enriched the students' learning experience.

- **B. ENGLISH AND HINDI DICTATION** –Spelling is a crucial component of the language and a foundational skill that the students will carry throughout their academic and professional life. Therefore, to widen children's vocabulary and to expose them to a richer set of linguistic patterns, English dictation and Hindi shrutlekh was conducted during bagless days.
- C. STORY NARRATION—Story narration is the spoken commentary to convey a story to the audience. It helps children to process what they have learnt and encourages use of imagination and creativity. Thus, to enhance students' verbal proficiency, imagination and creativity, story narration activity was conducted in the bagless days. All the students actively participated in the activity.
- **D. READING ACTIVITY –** In order to inculcate reading habits in students, reading activity was conducted. Students were asked to bring books. All the students enthusiastically participated in the activity.

Under the CBSE circular, APS Birpur actively took part in the Jal Shakti Abhiyaan "Catch the Rain" campaign, launched by the honorable Prime Minister. This initiative focuses on rainwater harvesting, water conservation, intensive afforestation, and involving young minds in the Jal Andolan. Students from classes 6 to 8 along with the teachers enthusiastically joined the campaign, and our NCC students played a pivotal role as Jaldoots, the school carried out various activities to fulfill the campaign's objectives. The activities undertaken included:

- 1. **Introduction of the activities-** In the morning assembly, Chetna Bohra, a student of class 8B, apprised the students from classes 6 to 8 about the campaign and outlined the activities to be undertaken. Teachers and students also took a pledge during the assembly, committing to not waste a single drop of water and actively participate in saving it.
- 2. **Painting competition-** NCC students participated in a painting competition, creating informative artworks on depicting various methods to conserve water and its recycling.
- 3. **Plantation-** Students planted various trees and plants to promote afforestation.
- 4. **Rally-** A rally was organized within the school campus by the Jaldoots to raise awareness about water conservation.
- 5. **Door to Door Awareness Campaign-** Jaldoots visited nearby residential quarters to educate the community about water conservation, recycling and reuse.
- 6. Workshops (Jalshalas)- Teachers conducted workshops in their respective classes, discussing topics such as the pH value of water, methods of water conservation, rainwater harvesting, and various government projects. These sessions utilized resources from magazines, newspapers, and the internet. The workshops were highly interactive, with students actively engaging by asking questions about different schemes. Additionally, students were instructed to gather information related to water conservation and management.

SUMMER CAMP ACTIVITIES (27, 28, 29,30 & 31 MAY 2024)

Yoga & Meditation

The students were introduced to the practice of Yoga. They began their session by engaging in warm-up exercises to prepare their bodies for the practice. Additionally,

they learned and practiced suksham vyayam and meditation. And it was performed daily after the attendance.





Poetry and Dramatics

Students enjoyed their poetry and dramatics sessions. They wrote poems and practised for the character and script of 'Merchant of Venice' which they enacted on the closing ceremony.

ZUMBA

Zumba is a form of aerobic fitness exercise based on Latin American Dance rhythms. The students enjoyed and learned some basic steps of Zumba dance. And practised on a song to perform on the closing day.





Robotics and AI

Students learnt the basics of 3D Printing and CAD Designing. The students of classes VI to VIII enjoyed sessions on CAD Designing & Doodling where they learnt how to use the 3D pen. Students of the class IX learnt the various tools of CAD Designing. Students made different types of 3D objects like Maps of India, Different types of Flowers & Buckets, Sunglasses and many more. Students were given the introduction of DRONES. The students of classes VI-IX were given an overview of working principle of Aerodyne such as Airplane, Helicopter & Glider. Students also learnt the various fields where Drones are being used now a days. They also learnt about Drones Assembling & working.







Football

The football event in the summer camp witnessed enthusiastic participation from students of classes 6 to 9. The students were divided into two groups: Group A consisting of students from classes 6 and 7, and Group B comprising students from classes 8 and 9.

The Children played group football matches after starting with warm-up exercises and some recreational fun games involving football fundamental skills like shooting throwing.



Basketball

Calligraphy
